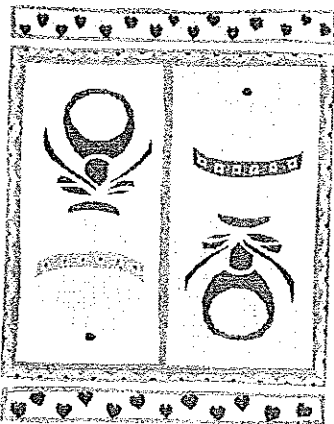
Infant News

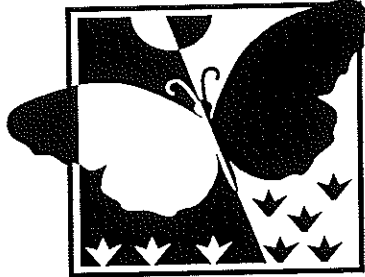
