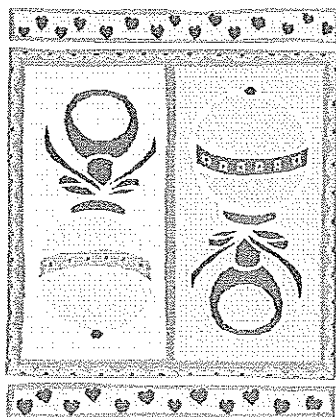

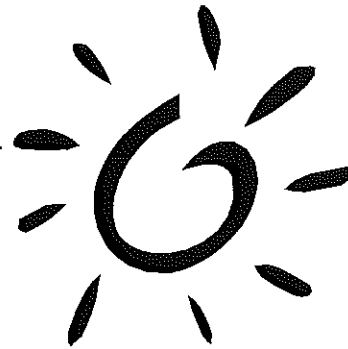
Preschool News: 3 Year Olds

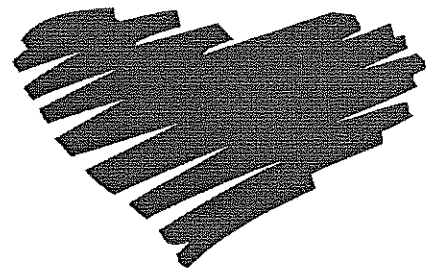
Preschool News: 4 Year Olds

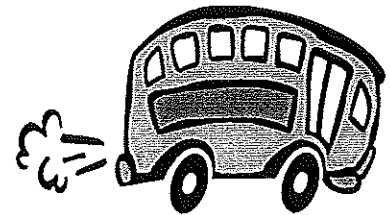


Kindergarten News
